

Referee Information

- Always be on time! Arrive 10 minutes before the game is scheduled to start.
- Required referee equipment – bring a whistle and watch. The referee jersey will be provided by one of the coaches. Must be returned at the end of the game.
- Introduce yourself to both coaches. They will be glad to see that the referees are on time and ready to start the game on time.
- For U12 and U10 follow the Rules of Soccer that were handed out and on the website.
- All games are to start on time. This means four 15 minute periods for U10 with 2 minutes between periods and 5 minutes between halves. For U12 two 30 minute halves with 5 minutes between periods. This will keep games on schedule.
- When making a call blow the whistle **LOUD** and explain why you're blowing the whistle. This will help keep the coaches and players informed.
- If you can't ref a game as scheduled, please find a replacement from the roster list. Make sure they are not scheduled to ref at the same time. If you can't find a replacement, call Mrs. Gray 685-5153.
- All refs will be paid after the game.

Always be polite to the coaches and players. People will notice and they will appreciate your politeness. If spectators give you a hard time don't argue with them-inform the coaches. If coaches give you a hard time please contact Mrs. Gray or any of the board members so it can be addressed.
